- 2) **History of the Church of the Brethren, Eastern Pennsylvania, 1915-1965**, by Church of the Brethren, Eastern District of PA, 1965, 357pp, hardcover, illustrated with black and white photos. Clean and unmarked.
- 3) **A Son of Thunder – Patrick Henry and the American Republic**, by Henry Mayer, Grove Press, 2006, 2<sup>nd</sup> printing, 529pp. Softcover in stiff illustrated gloss wrap, clean and in unread condition. Biography.
- 4) **The Prose Works of William Byrd of Westover: Narratives of a Colonial Virginian**, edited by Louis B. Wright, The Belknap Press of Harvard University Press, 1966, 1<sup>st</sup> Ed, 438 pp. Hardcover in maroon cloth, gilt title to spine. Signed and inscribed by author on front free endpaper: “To Ted Richardson, a token of the editor’s admiration. Louis B. Wright, May 1, 1966.” Otherwise unmarked.
